In the Classroom...

Reading

Every student must have a chapter book to read in class. Mrs. Raddish and Mrs. Young's class will be working on looking at different perspectives of an event. Both classes have Read and Responds to do each day this grading period. Mr. Guest's class will be revisiting plot and focusing on climax and falling action this week. Reading logs in Mr. Guest's class will happen again this week. **Make sure to read every night for at least 20 minutes.**

Writing

We will have a mentor sentence this week focusing on complex, compound, and simple sentences. The story is Henry's Freedom Box. We will also focus on idioms. There will be an idiom assignment due Thursday. There is a Mentor Quiz Thursday.

Math

Your child has a 10mm to complete this week and it is due Thursday. Mrs. Young's class is working on an Algebra Project Based Learning lesson. There is no homework this week. Mrs. Raddish's class we will be working on ordered pairs, function tables, and coordinate graphing this week. They have a coordinate graph picture due Thursday as a mastery grade. Mr. Guest's class will be continuing ordered pairs this week, and working on function tables.

Science
